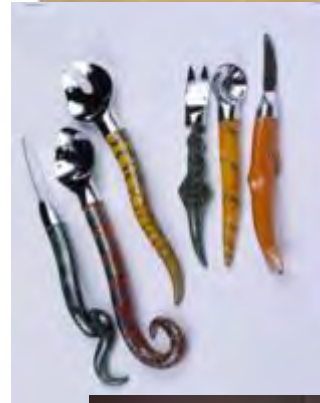


DESIGN COMPETITION FOR CRAFTS

The First International Design Competition was organized in 2002 by Artesanías de Colombia, the European Design Institute-Rome and the Colombian Embassy in Italy.





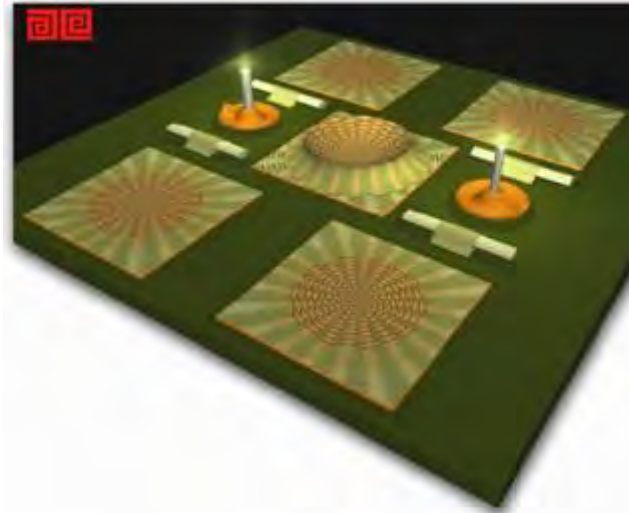

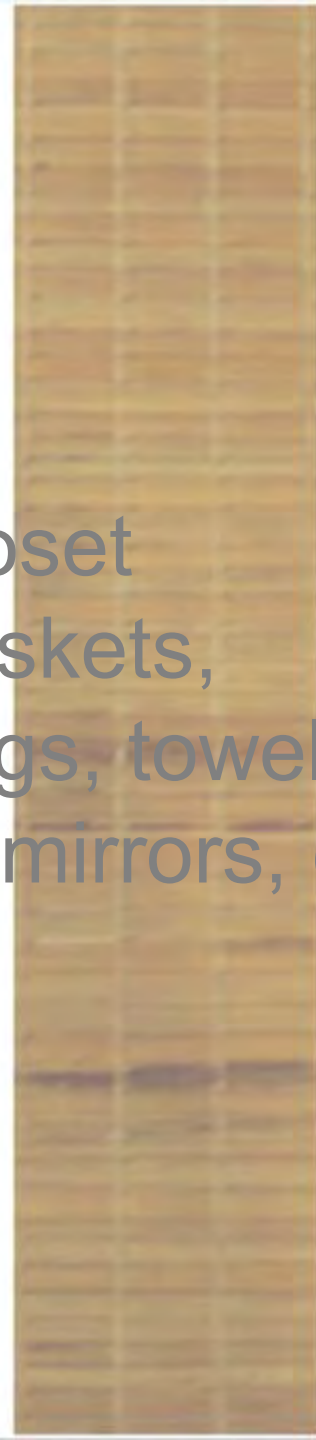
Conditions for Entries

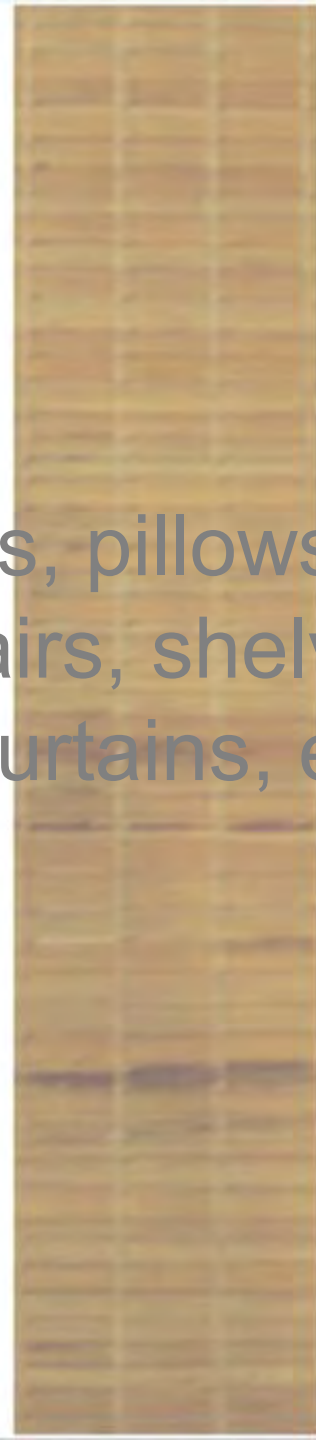






Bedroom Accessories

- Sheets, bed covers, blankets, pillows, cushions, throws, sofas, chairs, shelves, night tables, mirrors, rugs, curtains, etc.



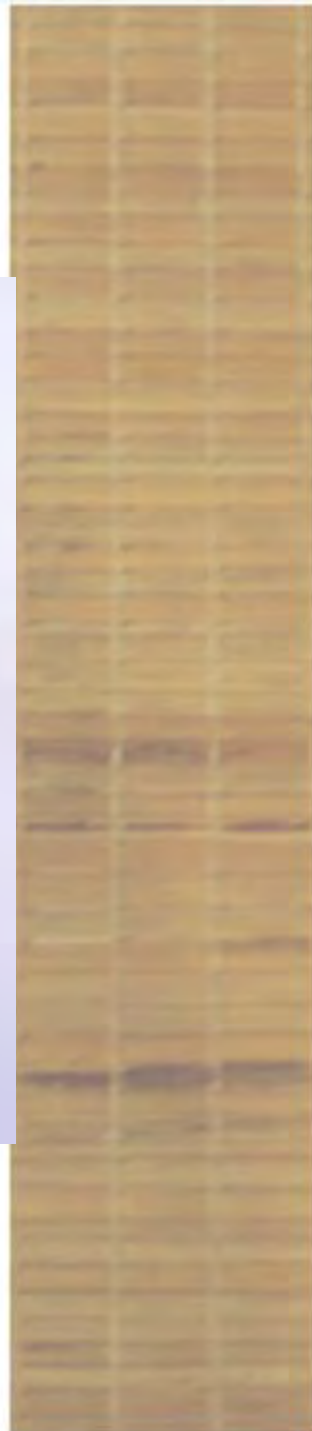


















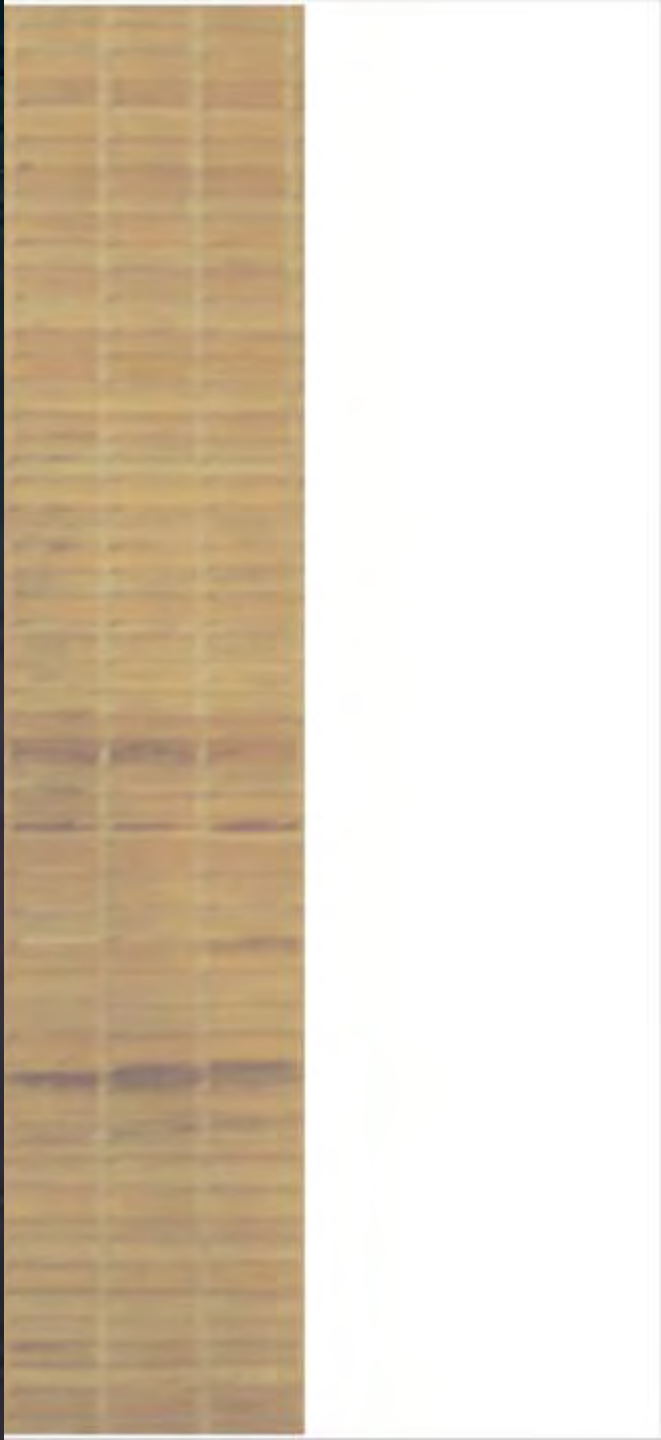
















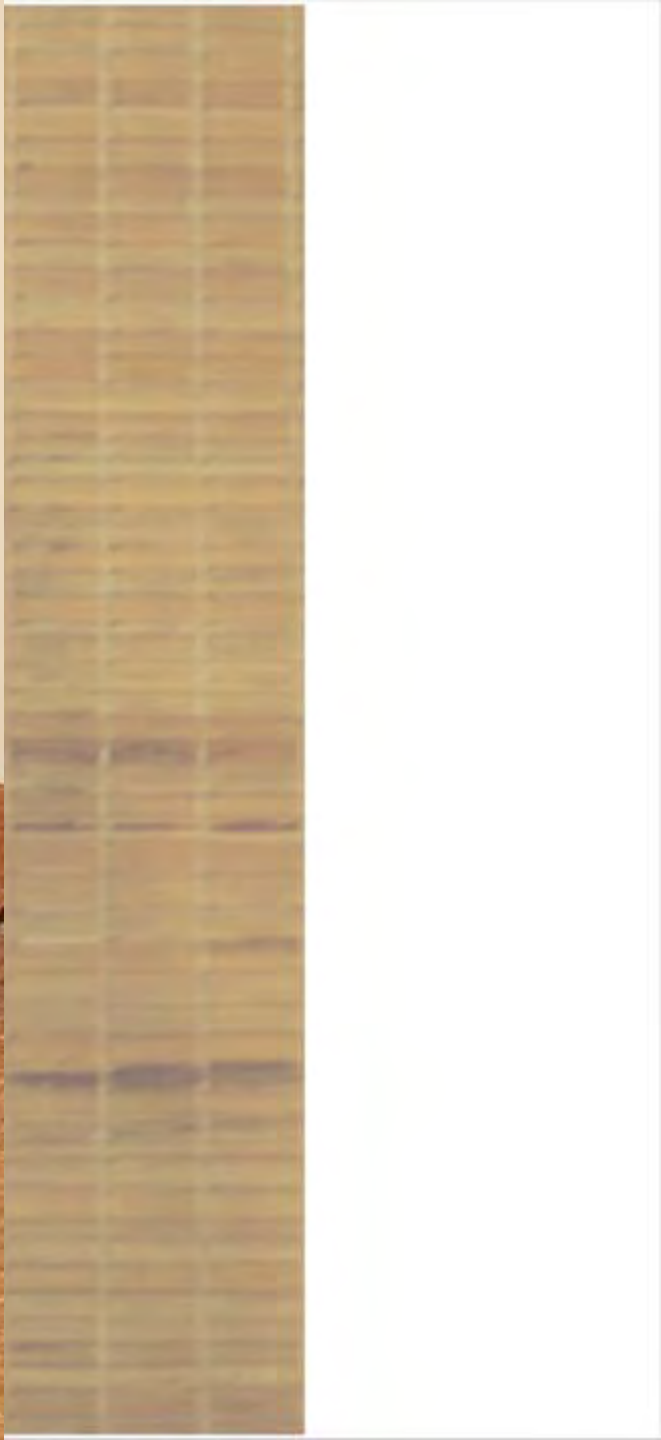
















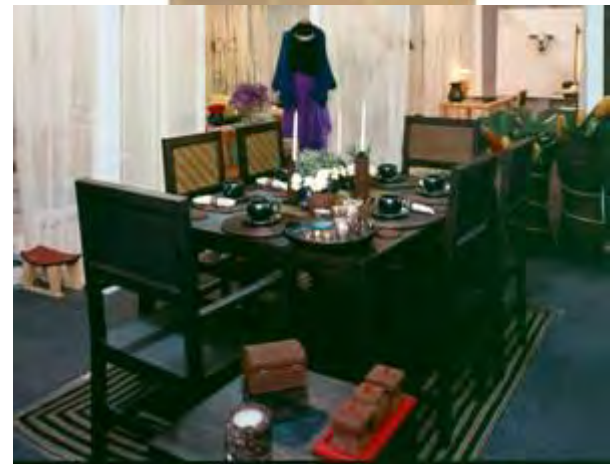
